What a year! **2018 saw a record-breaking 200+ kids involved in our shows** – onstage and off. (We're on track to smash that record again this year!) The season included an ambitious production of *Pippin* (in collaboration with Circus Culture – a partnership we'll reprise this June for *The Wiz*), a sweet telling of *The Wind in the Willows*, a whimsical *James and the Giant Peach*, a poignant *Songs for a New World*, and a shredalicious *School of Rock*.

Most significantly, of course, 2018 is the year that R2P has begun our journey home. **After more than a decade on the road, we're in the midst of creating a permanent theatre to call our very own.** Construction is underway at the Shops at Ithaca Mall to transform the former and long-abandoned movie theaters into a custom-made theatre complete with a 300-seat auditorium, scene shop, dressing rooms, dance studio, and much more.
